

BPJS Kesehatan Salurkan Bantuan Korban Banjir Kalimantan Barat

Pontianak (26/11/2021) – BPJS Kesehatan menyerahkan bantuan bagi para korban bencana banjir di Provinsi Kalimantan Barat, Jumat (26/11). Sekretaris BPJS Kesehatan, Arief Syaefuddin mengatakan bahwa pihaknya menyampaikan rasa prihatin atas musibah yang menimpa masyarakat setempat yang terkena dampak musibah tersebut.

“Sebagai bentuk kepedulian kami terhadap masyarakat yang terkena dampak musibah banjir ini, BPJS Kesehatan memberikan bantuan berupa 1.000 paket sembako. Meski secara jumlah, mungkin bantuan yang diberikan tidak terlalu banyak. Namun, dengan bantuan yang diberikan, harapannya bisa membantu meringankan beban masyarakat yang terdampak dari musibah ini,” ujar Arief.

Turut mendampingi Sekretaris BPJS Kesehatan, Deputi Direksi BPJS Kesehatan Wilayah Banten, Kalimantan Barat dan Lampung, Lisa Nurena dan Kepala BPJS Kesehatan Cabang Pontianak, Adiwani Qodar.

Arief menyebutkan, untuk proses pendistribusian, pihaknya langsung menyerahkan sepenuhnya kepada Pemerintah Provinsi Kalimantan Barat yang lebih memahami karakter dan mengetahui wilayah mana saja yang masih terdampak dan membutuhkan bantuan.

“Semoga musibah banjir yang menimpa di wilayah Kalimantan Barat ini dapat segera surut seluruhnya sehingga aktivitas masyarakat dapat kembali normal seperti biasa,” ucap Arief usai menyerahkan bantuan secara simbolis.

Sementara itu, Deputi Direksi BPJS Kesehatan Wilayah Banten, Kalimantan Barat dan Lampung, Lisa Nurena memastikan bahwa pelayanan bagi peserta JKN-KIS terus berjalan dengan optimal. Meski ada beberapa kantor cabang yang tertutup akses karena dilanda banjir, namun dirinya terus mengatakan bahwa peserta masih dapat mengakses layanan kepesertaan JKN-KIS.

“Kami terus memastikan bahwa pelayanan di kantor cabang tetap bisa diakses oleh peserta JKN-KIS. Bukan hanya pelayanan dengan tatap muka, peserta JKN-KIS juga bisa memanfaatkan layanan digital BPJS Kesehatan melalui aplikasi Mobile JKN, Pelayanan Administrasi melalui Whatsapp (PANDAWA), Chat Assistant JKN (CHIKA) hingga BPJS Kesehatan Care Center 165,” tambah Lisa.

Pada kesempatan yang sama, Gubernur Kalimantan Barat, Sutarmidji mengucapkan terima kasih atas bantuan yang diberikan BPJS Kesehatan kepada masyarakat di wilayah Kalimantan Barat yang terkena dampak musibah banjir.

“Terkait proses pendistribusian, nantinya akan disalurkan ke daerah yang memang masih membutuhkan bantuan diantaranya Kapuas Hulu yang saat ini banjirnya masih tergolong tinggi. Harapannya bantuan yang ada dapat memberi manfaat bagi warga yang menerima,” tutup Sutarmidji. (FR/)

BPJS Kesehatan Provides Assistance for West Kalimantan Flood Victims

Pontianak (26/11/2021) – BPJS Kesehatan handed over the aid for flood victims in West Kalimantan Province, Friday (26/11). Secretary of BPJS Kesehatan, Arief Syaefuddin said that his party expressed his concern for the disaster that befell the local community.

"As a form of our concern for the people affected by this flood, BPJS Kesehatan provides assistance in the form of 1,000 basic food packages. Although in terms of numbers, perhaps the assistance provided is not too much. However, we hope that the assistance can help ease the burden of the people who got affected by this disaster," said Arief.

BPJS Kesehatan Deputy Directors of Banten, West Kalimantan and Lampung Regions, Lisa Nurena and Head of BPJS Kesehatan Pontianak Branch, Adiwana Qodar also attended on this occasion to accompany Secretary of BPJS Kesehatan.

Arief said, for the distribution process, his party immediately handed it over completely to the West Kalimantan Provincial Government, which better understands the areas that are still affected and need assistance.

"Hopefully the floods that hit the West Kalimantan region can immediately subside completely so that community activities can return to normal as usual," said Arief after handing over the aid symbolically.

Meanwhile, Deputy Directors of BPJS Kesehatan Banten, West Kalimantan and Lampung, Lisa Nurena ensured that services for JKN-KIS participants continued to run optimally. Although there are several branch offices that are closed due to the flood, she said that participants can still access JKN-KIS membership services.

"We continue to ensure that services at branch offices can still be accessed by JKN-KIS participants. Not only face-to-face services, JKN-KIS participants can also take advantage of BPJS Kesehatan digital services through Mobile JKN application, Administration Services via Whatsapp (PANDAWA), Chat Assistant (CHIKA) JKN and BPJS Kesehatan Care Center 165," added Lisa.

On the same occasion, the Governor of West Kalimantan, Sutarmidji, expressed his gratitude for the assistance from BPJS Kesehatan to the communities who are affected by the flood in West Kalimantan.

"Regarding the distribution process, later it will be distributed to areas that still need assistance, including Kapuas Hulu, which currently has a high flood level. We hope that the existing assistance can help the people who receive it," concluded Sutarmidji. (FR/)
